<ul> <li>Employee Assistance Programme</li> <li>BSU staff have access to Sage employee benefits which is a website and App that BSU staff can access to gain a wealth of online well-being resources to support their mental, physical, social and financial wellbeing.</li> </ul>	None
<ul> <li>Working from Home</li> <li>BSU will consider any reasonable requests from staff to work from home (on a part-time, full-time or temporary basis) to enable a better work/life balance.</li> <li>This type of arrangement isn't suitable for all roles within the Union so for those members of staff, BSU will consider other options in order to try and meet the needs of the individual and the business.</li> </ul>	Following successful completion of probation period
<ul> <li>We appreciate that not everyone wants to work a standard 9-5 day and BSU offer a level of flexibility with working hours that will help to improve work/life balance.</li> <li>This may not be feasible for those staff in front facing roles so consideration will be given to the nature of the job and the needs of the business.</li> <li>Meeting free lunchtimes – where feasible</li> <li>Potential for early finish Fridays – agreed at a local level and in line with business needs.</li> </ul>	None

<ul> <li>Volunteering days</li> <li>BSU understands that volunteering not only benefits the local community but also the wellbeing of our staff.</li> <li>To enable staff to do this, those eligible may be able to take up to 2 days on full pay (per calendar year) to undertake voluntary work for a charitable cause that is of interest to them.</li> </ul>	Following successful completion of probation period

<ul> <li>Excellent training opportunities</li> <li>In addition to the compulsory training when you start your employment, BSU offer a variety of additional inhouse training to staff.</li> <li>Recent training has included Resilience, mental wellbeing, management skills, etc.</li> <li>BSU staff are also eligible to access many of the courses available to University staff, free of charge.</li> <li>Further information will be made available to you during the Induction process.</li> </ul>	None
<ul> <li>Study Leave</li> <li>Employees studying a professional qualification may be eligible for study leave to help manage their studies and meet specific deadlines - especially when taking exams.</li> <li>Timings of any leave granted will be dependent on the needs of the business.</li> </ul>	Dependent on role

<ul> <li>To ensure a fair and consistent approach is used when setting the salary for an Established role, consideration will be given to the level of responsibility of various aspects of the job.</li> <li>All BSU roles will be placed in an appropriate Grade that is consistent with similar jobs within the Union.</li> </ul>	None
<ul> <li>Incremental Increases</li> <li>Pay Scales are sub-divided into Spinal Points.</li> <li>Staff will normally start at the bottom of a Salary Grade and rise up the scales until they have reached the top of the Grade.</li> <li>In April of each year, eligible staff salaries will be increased to the next Spinal Point.</li> <li>A copy of the Salary Grades can be found in the HR section of the BSU intranet.</li> </ul>	Following successful completion of probation period

#### **Pension Scheme**

- BSU administer 2 Pension Funds a NEST and AEGON Scheme which staff can join if they wish.
- Staff will automatically be enrolled onto the BSU NEST fund as and when they become eligible in line with Government guidelines.
- Staff will routinely contribute 4% to their fund but may increase this if they wish.

- BSU will contribute a minimum of 4%, which is above the statutory requirement, and will match up to a maximum of 6% for Established Staff contributions.
- Staff are advised to seek independent pension advice before deciding on which is the best option for them and their family.

<ul> <li>Sickness Entitlement</li> <li>It is inevitable that there will be times when employees are not fit to work and BSU offer enhanced Sic to ensure enough time is taken for the individual to fully recover.</li> <li>Employees are entitled to up to 3 months full pay Sickness Leave in any rolling 12-month period.</li> </ul>	ck Leave Following successful completion of 1st part of probation period
<ul> <li>Staff may be eligible to take between 3 and 12 months unpaid Sabbatical Leave with the security of k that their job will be kept open for the duration of the leave.</li> <li>This leave can be taken to enable staff to spend time pursuing a personal interest, spending time with or to enhance their skills and assist with future development.</li> <li>Agreement to any such leave will be discretional and considered in line with business needs.</li> </ul>	After 3 years'
